

These findings were woven into poetry and then translated into 'ōlelo Hawai'i (Hawaiian language) by Kumu Melelani Pang as a gift to Damien Memorial School.

Our Kamiano Lū'au visual symbolizes the three lo'i kalo near Damien. The water imagery depicts the wealth of our water resources that feed us. We are connected through the generations of students and families that share our special place and these hallways, our school. For our alumni, we welcome you home. For our students, the path is set for you by these distinguished alumni. For our families, you have trusted us with your most precious resource, your child. We mahalo you for the part of this journey that we share. Viriliter Age!


